1.1. **Description.** Facility manages all aspects of the aerial bombing and gunnery training range used by combat aircraft to attack ground targets (air-to-ground bombing), or a remote area reserved for researching, developing, testing, and evaluating new weapons and ammunition. They coordinate operational and support matters with major commands, other services, DOE and Department of Interior, as well as other federal, state, and local government agencies. This facility can also be used for mission briefing and debriefing. All SCIF space will be captured in CATCode 140422 SCIF.

1.2. **Requirements Determination.** Contact the MAJCOM for non-administrative mission specific space requirements.

1.3. **Scope Determination.** The administration spaces, office sizes, conference rooms, break rooms etc. are based on Facility Class 6, Administrative; Category Group 61, Administrative and Administrative Support Spaces. See Table 1.1.

1.4. **Design Considerations.** Obtain additional information from MAJCOM sources.
